In this role, you will work with the other coaches to plan and run three weekly practices for masters scullers of various experience levels. The sculling team is a tight-knit and fun group of competitive athletes who are eager to continue learning and training! We are looking for candidates with sculling and coaching experience who have a passion for sharing their knowledge about the sport.

SRA has four unique masters teams, in addition to independent rowers and a large junior team. As a part of the SRA Masters Program, you will need to coordinate with other teams and coaches while attending regular coaches meetings. The sculling team practices Tuesday and Thursday from 6:00 - 8:00 am and Saturday from 8:00 - 10:00 am. The coaches work together to develop a training plan, make lineups, teach technical skills, and prepare for and attend regattas throughout the spring, summer and fall.
